

Using ZELLE to make your Annual Assessment payment

Homeowners have been asking for a way to pay directly (electronically) from their bank to the bank used by the HOA.

We have researched a wide variety of payment methods. We were looking for a method that was 1) instant, 2) free to all parties, 3) easy to use, and most important, 4) secure.

Most major banks now use "Peer to Peer" money transfers, usually, but not always, called "Zelle". Zelle is 3 times as large as PayPal.

This is an online banking feature. You need to sign up on your online banking app. This is very fast and easy. One homeowner signed up and sent his money while we were on the phone talking about it.

Then to use this system:

You don't give your (or our) bank routing numbers or any personal information.

You only need to know the email that we use to accept the money and the first and last name used by our Zelle account.

Go to your bank's online app or website, go to transfers and give our special email, our first and last name and the amount and it's done.

Again, ONLY for money transfers (Aspen Meadows subdivision)

First name: Aspen

Last name: Meadows

Your money is transferred instantly to our account, no delay as in a wire transfer.

We immediately get notified by email that you paid and you immediately get an email that verifies payment, which will be your receipt. No fees.

Zelle is rapidly becoming more popular, even being advertised on TV. Anyone who has an online Zelle account can transfer to and from anyone else who has a Zelle account.

BTW: This is but one payment option. Checks, money orders, and cashiers checks are always welcome.

For your protection, use Zelle through your online banking, not through any stand alone app.
